THE WORD OF GOD

The Church Year celebrates the Mysteries of Faith, the Birth, the Public Ministry, the Passion, Death, Resurrection and Ascension of Our Saviour Our Lord Jesus Christ and the coming of the Holy Spirit. The Year begins on the First Sunday of Advent and concludes with the octave of the Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King of the Universe.

The particular readings at Masses are taken from Sacred Scripture depending on the season and on the occasion of the celebration. The importance of reading and listening to the Word of God is reflected in the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* no 29 which says that when Sacred Scriptures are read in Church, God Himself speaks to His people, and Christ, present in His Word, proclaims the Gospel.

Throughout the Year there are designated Days of Prayer. One of the more recent of these is the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time designated as the Sunday of the Word of God. This was instituted by Pope Francis in his Apostolic Letter *Aperuit illis* on the feast of St Jerome in 2019. Pope Francis began the Letter with the words 'He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures' (Lk 24:45) and continued '*This was one of the final acts of the risen Lord before his Ascension. Jesus appeared to the assembled disciples, broke bread with them and opened their minds to the understanding of the sacred Scriptures. To them, amid their fear and bewilderment, he unveiled the meaning of the paschal mystery: that in accordance with the Father's eternal plan he had to suffer and rise from the dead, in order to bring repentance and the forgiveness of sins (cf. Lk 24:26.46-47). He*



then promised to send the Holy Spirit, who would give them strength to be witnesses of this saving mystery (cf. Lk 24:49).

When we say the Rosary, as Our Lady asked us, we reflect on the Word of God in the mysteries of the Rosary and through the prayers comprising the Rosary. The mysteries (Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and Luminous) portray Christ's life. The Rosary is described as a Scripture based prayer on the website of the *US Conference of Bishops* which says the Rosary 'begins with the Apostles Creed which summarizes the great mysteries of the Catholic Faith. The Our Father which introduces each mystery is from the Gospels. The first part of the Hail Mary is the Angel's words announcing Christ's Birth and Elizabeth's greeting to Mary'.



There are many days during the Year devoted to honouring Our Blessed Lady as events during her life, her apparitions and her position within the Church are celebrated. These include the solemnity of Mary the Mother of God; the solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord; the memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church; the feast of Our Lady of Fatima and her apparitions there; the solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary; the solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Saturday Memorials of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

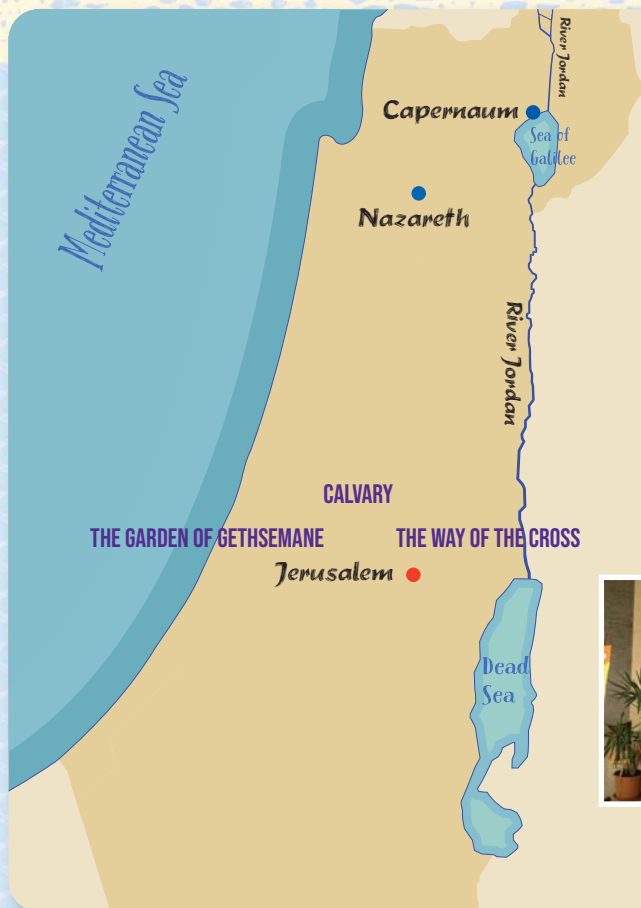

THE WEDDING AT CANA



There was a wedding in Cana of Galilee and the Mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and His disciples had also been invited to the wedding. When the wine ran out the Mother of Jesus said to Him 'they have no wine'. And Jesus said to her ... 'My hour has not yet come'. His Mother said to the servants 'Do whatever He tells you'. Now standing there were six stone water jars...each holding twenty or thirty gallons. Jesus said to them 'fill the jars with water' and they filled them up to the brim. He said to them 'now draw some out and take it to the chief steward... When the steward tasted the water that had become wine...he called the bridegroom and said to him ... 'you have kept the good wine until now'. Jesus did this, the first of His signs, in Cana of Galilee, and revealed His glory; and His disciples believed in Him..

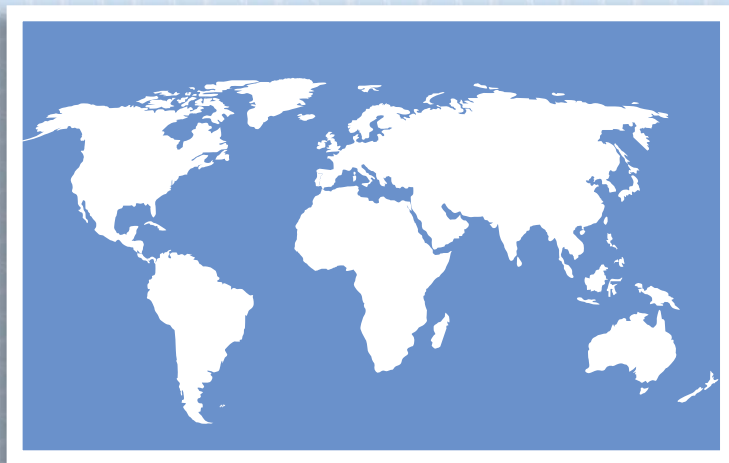
